HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHT

200 YEARS AGO - 1788

August 1788 - The Lodge moved into Joseph Greenway's. Joseph Greenway was the Lodge Secretary, an office he held until 1795.

"Stern rebuke was administered to Robert A-----, Esq., on the 23rd, for indulging in too much "Social Mirth". "Robert A-----, being present for advancement to the degree of F.C. was found to be in a state of intoxication, where-upon he was withdrawn from the Lodge, and his advancement postponed. He was required to show himself entitled to further advancement by his future conduct." All Stated Meetings being held in the E.A. Degree, he could still attend lodge meetings, however, there is no record of where and when he was advanced.

August 2 - North Carolina refuses to ratify the Constitution, and proposes ammendments, namely a bill of rights.
