Over 100 Masons from across the United States will be joining us as we host the Second Annual Symposium of the Masonic Restoration Foundation (MRF), from August 19-21. The MRF is a Masonic educational foundation whose goal is to cultivate and develop a culture of learning and growth within the American Craft by encouraging and demonstrating quality programs, academic excellence and social relevance within the Masonic community. This three-day event will include panels, discussions, a degree in the Lodge on Saturday afternoon, and a special reception at Gadsby's Ballroom in Old Town on Saturday evening.

It begins on Friday evening at 7:30 PM, with a special Festive Board, to be held in Grand Masonic Hall. Our keynote speaker for the evening will be Julian Rees, who gave such an excellent presentation to our Lodge last year. Julian is a Past Junior Grand Deacon of the United Grand Lodge of England, a contributing editor to *Freemasonry Today*, and one of the most prolific Masonic authors of our time.

Attendance at the Symposium is free to members of our Lodge, but you must register in order to attend.
