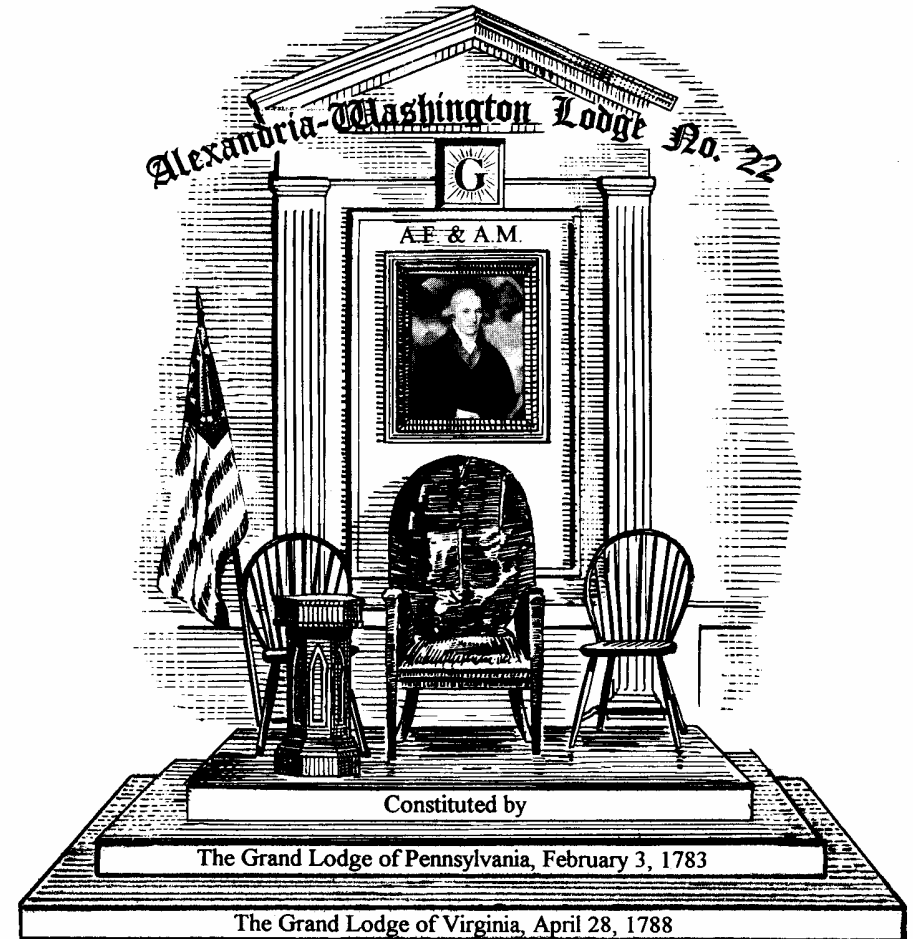


The lodge will participate in the George Washington Birthday reception hosted at 1:00 PM by the George Washington Masonic National Memorial. This event will include their annual presentation of the George Washington Memorial Award.

A called communication of the lodge will begin Saturday the 21st at 4:30 PM in the American Legion dining hall adjoining Gadsby's Tavern. The purpose of this meeting is the official visit of Most Worshipful Brother Jeffery Eugene Hodges, Grand Master of Masons in Virginia. The called communication will be followed by a table lodge to honor Illustrious Brother George Washington. Ladies are invited to tour Carlyle House at 4:00 PM. This historic home was the residence of a contemporary of Washington and should provide an interesting view of 18th century life in Old Town Alexandria.
