

From the Secretary's Desk-

Now that we are into the new masonic year, past January 1, 2018, if you have not paid your 2018 dues you are considered delinquent. Dues must be paid by January 1st

to be considered in good standing for that year. You can pay your dues through the Lodge Web site at http://aw22.org If you decide to pay by sending the funds to the Secretary, you must pay by personal check or by Money Order. Federal Regulations do not allow you to pay dues with a company or business check. It must be personal funds. I just learned this fact when we had our annual audit of the Secretary and Treasurer books. Of course, if you are one of the twelve (12) members who have not paid your 2017 dues as yet, you are now over one year delinquent and I must start the process of suspension for non-payment of dues. Also, the cost of a Life Membership in Perpetuity as of January 1, 2018 went to \$4,011.00 and 2018 dues must be paid when you apply. The new cost for the year 2018 only is based on 21 times the 2019 dues at \$191.00. On January 1, 2019 the cost goes to \$4,393.00 (23 times \$191.00) and on January 1, 2020 the cost goes to \$4,775.00 (25 times \$191.00). Please contact me if you have any questions.
