Rather than offer a separate program in Lodge, I thought this would be a great opportunity for the brethren to learn a bit more about an historical figure and brother who has his own connection to both Washington and our Lodge. We will gather in our Lodge anteroom at 6:45, move together to the North Lodge Room, and then begin our stated communication after the lecture.

The speaker is Marc Leepson, author of Lafayette: Lessons in Leadership from the Idealist General. Mr. Leepson is an accomplished journalist, historian, and the author of eight books, most recently What So Proudly We Hailed, the first biography of the author of "The Star-Spangled Banner" in more than 75 years. His previous books include Desperate Engagement, the story of the Civil War Battle of Monocacy and Confederate General Jubal Early's attack on Washington; Flag: An American Biography, and Saving Monticello: The Levy Family's Epic Quest to Rescue the House that Jefferson Built). He edited The Webster's New World Dictionary of the Vietnam War, and wrote two books on health topics in the 1980s.
